Staff Appreciation recognize all that MVS staff does throughout the year with luncheons and staff treats, dinner during parent-teacher conferences, staff birthday cards, water service for the teacher lounge.

Classroom Volunteer Support develop programs to help match volunteers with teacher needs; facilitate parent volunteers and parent visits to the classroom, on field trips, parties, etc.

School Store sell school supplies, at cost, to students. Committee volunteers will work in the store.

Carnival and Halloween Dance coordinate all aspects of these two major events.

Partnerships seek and recognize new partnerships, contact past partners, maintain records.

Fundraising research, recommend, and administer fundraising events.

Label Programs investigate, collect, maintain records, and promote Box Tops and other label-reward programs (Campbell's, Tyson). Plan and coordinate submission dates and contests.

Reward Programs research, maintain records, and recommend reward opportunities to Executive Board for approval (i.e., Frys Cool Cash, Target Card, etc.).

Donations and Grants record, request, acknowledgement, and receipt of donations. Seek donations from local businesses. Research grants for teachers and staff.
